PERSONAL PROPERTY FORMS TO BE MAILED BY THE COUNTY APPRAISERS OFFICE

Personal Property Rendition forms will be mailed out by the Neosho County appraiser's office at the end of December. They are due back in the appraiser's office by March 15th.

These forms include a computer printout listing of the items reported in 2017, according to Mr. McElroy the county appraiser. Residents and Business in Neosho County need to make corrections by deleting items disposed of and adding new items. If you have received a form but no longer have personal property in Neosho County you still must mark the box that you no longer own or control any personal property and return the rendition to the appraiser's office. If there are no changes, sign the form and return to the county appraiser's office by March 15.

Mr. McElroy emphasizes that you return your rendition before the filing deadline or receive a penalty under KSA 79-1422. The penalties for late filing are: Within 30 days, 5%; within 60 days, 10%; 90 days, 15%; 120 days, 20%; over 120 days, 25%; and failure to file is 50%.
